COURSE CONTENT: Cybersecurity is an essential part of the daily lives of not only businesses, ministries and the state, but also ordinary users of the Internet and devices connected to it. It covers everything related to the protection of personal information, intellectual property, data, and government and industry information systems from theft and damage. Cyberhygiene is the basic rules of digital (cyber) security when working on the Internet. Due to the massive increase in the number of Internet frauds, cyberhygiene has become a hot topic of discussion in society in recent years. The course will help You to learn about the main threats in the digital space, understand what information is the main target of hackers and remember the basic recommendations for protecting Your data, safe use of electronic devices and information resources.
