General information

Summary

The acquisition by students of fundamental knowledge of the history and culture of Ukraine, as the basis for the formation of the worldview of a responsible citizen, the bearer of intellectual, moral and aesthetic qualities worthy of a highly educated specialist. The course is designed to provide students with the ability to independently analyze historical processes, causes and consequences of certain events, etc.

Course objectives and goals

The acquisition by students of fundamental knowledge of the history and culture of Ukraine, as the basis for the formation of the worldview of a responsible citizen, the bearer of intellectual, moral, and aesthetic qualities worthy of a highly educated specialist. The course is designed to provide students with the ability to independently analyze historical processes, causes and consequences of certain events, etc

Format of classes

Lectures, seminar classes, independent work (preparation of essays, historical essays), consultations. The final control is an exam.

Student workload

The total volume of the course is 90 hours (3 ECTS credits): lectures - 16 hours, seminars - 16 hours, self-study - 58 hours.

Course prerequisites

History of Ukraine in the scope provided for by the secondary school curriculum.

Features of the course, teaching and learning methods, and technologies

The course is not a repetition of the History of Ukraine school course. The issues under consideration are presented according to the problem-chronological method. Based on previously acquired knowledge, students study cause-and-effect connections, modern relevant concepts of historical science and humanities in general, etc. Students have the opportunity to gain experience in public speaking, discussions, writing scientific papers, etc.

Topic 1. Introduction to the Course. Kyivan Rus'.

Topic 2. Ukrainian Lands in the Period of the Cossack State's Existence (the Middle of the 17th – in the Late 18th Centuries).

Topic 3. Revolutionary Events of 1917-1921 in Ukraine: Causes, Driving Forces, Consequences

Topic 4. Development of Ukraine in 1945-1985: Main Tendencies and Contradictions.

Topic 5. The essence of culture. The concepts of Ukrainian culture.

Topic 6. Ukrainian culture of the Middle Ages.

Topic 7. Ukrainian culture in the Modern Time (17th – 18th centuries).

Topic 8. Contemporary Ukrainian culture.

Topics of the workshops

Topic 1. Ukrainian Lands within the States of Lithuania and Poland (the Middle 14th – the 1st Half of the 17th Centuries).

Topic 2. Ukraine under the Authority of the Russian and Austrian (Austro-Hungarian) Empires in the Late 18th – in the Early 20th centuries.

Topic 3. Ukraine in the Interwar Period. Ukrainian Question on the Eve and during the World War II.

Topic 4. Ukraine during the Period of «Perestroika», the Collapse of the USSR (1985-1991). Development of Independent Ukraine.

Topic 5. Ancient culture in the territory of Ukraine.

Topic 6. Ukrainian Renaissance (14th – 15th centuries).

Topic 7. Ukrainian 19th century culture.

Topic 8. Culture of Sloboda Ukraine.
