The course covers the entrepreneurship process from idea to validated business model development and ends with a demo day where teams present their ideas to the jury. The process is integrated with reflections on teaching methods that can be used in teaching.</p> <p>The course provides entrepreneurship skills and teaching methods that can be integrated into the teaching process.</p> <p>In order to ensure transferability into practice, the course design is based on learning-by-doing, where the central element is collaborative learning in groups.
