The course covers the entrepreneurship process from idea to validated business model development and ends with a demo day where teams present their ideas to the jury. The process is integrated with reflections on teaching methods that can be used in teaching.  The course provides entrepreneurship skills and teaching methods that can be integrated into the teaching process.  In order to ensure transferability into practice, the course design is based on learning-by-doing, where the central element is collaborative learning in groups.
