General information

Summary

The course is aimed at students getting a general idea of the higher education system and at studying the basic roles and requirements for managers related to their professional activities, leadership and communication. The emphasis is on critical thinking, teamwork and effective communication.

Course objectives and goals

To form a general idea of the higher education system in Ukraine and the world; to reveal the subject area of management and its functions, to enhance students' capacity for critical thinking, teamwork and communication.

Format of classes

Workshops, consultations, self-study. Final control in the form of a differentiated grading.
