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General information

Summary

The "Jurisprudence" course provides knowledge and develops skills necessary for effective management of enterprises, institutions and organizations. In the process of mastering the course, students will learn how to apply various legal norms in order to improve production processes, provide services and effectively achieve strategic goals in the activities of legal entities.

Course objectives and goals

The assimilation by future specialists of normative legal acts of current Ukrainian legislation, international legal acts ratified by Ukraine, which regulate social relations arising in our country between individuals, legal entities and the state.

Format of classes

Lectures, laboratory classes, consultations, self-study, essays. Final control in the form of a Differentiated grading.

Student workload

The total scope of the discipline is 120 hours (4 ECTS credits): lectures – 32 hours, practical lessons – 16 hours, independent work – 72 hours.

Course prerequisites

The course is elementary and requires knowledge at the level of secondary education.

Features of the course, teaching and learning methods, and technologies

Lectures are conducted using multimedia technologies. Game methods are used in practical classes, attention to information technologies in law enforcement is emphasized. Educational materials are placed in Teams.

Topics of the lectures

Topic 1. Law as a social system.

Concepts and signs of law. Functions and principles of law. System of law and its structure. Sources of law.

Topic 2. Constitutional law of Ukraine.

Basics of the constitutional system in Ukraine. Basics of the legal status of a person and a citizen in Ukraine. Constitutional and legal status of the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine. Constitutional and legal status of the President of Ukraine. Constitutional and legal status of executive authorities in Ukraine.

Topic 3. Civil law of Ukraine as a branch of law.

Subject and method of civil law. Civil legislation. The concept and content of civil legal relations. The concept of objects of civil law, their classification.

Topic 4. Subjects of civil law.

Legal status of subjects of civil law. Legal personality of natural persons. Legal entities: concepts, features, classification.

Topic 5. Civil law contract.

The concept, meaning and functions of a contract in civil law. System of civil legal contracts. Conclusion, modification and termination of the contract.

Topic 6. Protection of private rights.

The concept of a claim and its signs. Limitation of claims. Protection of the rights of subjects of civil law. Protection of consumer rights.

Topic 7. Marital and family legal relations.

Marriage and conditions of its conclusion. State registration of marriage. Property relations in marriage and family. Personal non-property relations in marriage and family. Termination of marriage.

Topic 8. Labor relations.

Labor law as a branch of law. Concept, parties and content of an employment contract. An employment contract as a special form of an employment contract. Grounds for termination of employment relations. Material responsibility of employees. The procedure for consideration of individual disputes. The procedure for resolving collective disputes (conflicts). Concepts of social protection and social security. Pension security in Ukraine.

Topic 9. Fundamentals of administrative and criminal law of Ukraine.

Administrative legal relations: concepts and their types. Concepts and signs of an administrative offense. Types of administrative fines. Criminal law as a branch of law. The concept of a criminal offense and responsibility for its commission. Procedure for administrative and criminal liability.

Topics of the workshops

Law: concepts, features, functions. The legal system and its structure. Sources of law. Laws and by-laws.

Topic 2. Constitutional law of Ukraine.

Constitutional system in Ukraine. Legal status of a person and a citizen in Ukraine.

The concept, content and signs of civil legal relations. Property legal relations, their characteristics. Ownership. Personal non-property legal relations.

Topic 4. Deeds.

Concept of transactions, conditions of their validity.
