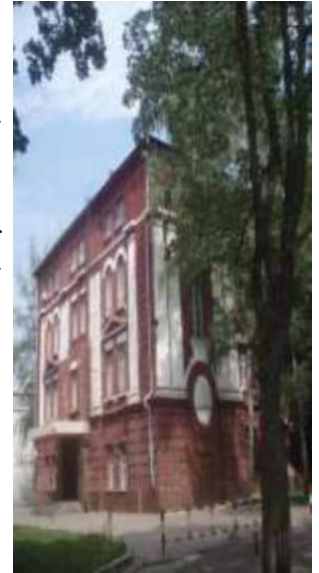

Name of the thesis - without hyphenations, in capital letters, bold, centered; next line - names and surnames of the authors, bold; next line - organization (name, city, country), bold, italics. Submissions deadline: **2022, October 31.**
