Please note that the volume of the collection is limited. Conditions for accepting abstracts: 1) relevance to the roundtable topic; 2) originality of the text; 3) presence of relevance, novelty, and practical significance; 4) adherence to formatting rules and the submission deadline.

Deadline for receiving and processing participant applications: 22.04.2026

Requirements for formatting materials:

- Length of abstracts: up to 5 pages (inclusive) in Microsoft Word text editor, as a file with the extension *.doc or *.docx, A4 size (297x210 mm), portrait orientation.
- Margins: left – 25 mm, right – 10 mm, top, bottom – 20 mm.
- Font: Times New Roman, size – 14, line spacing – 1.5, style – Normal.
- On the first line, center the section title; on the next line, right-aligned, indicate information about the author: last name, first name, and patronymic (in full), academic degree, academic title, position, name of the institution/educational establishment. Then, centered, in bold, indicate the title of the abstracts, followed by the text.
- The list of information sources is placed at the end of the text and formatted according to the existing bibliographic description standard (*DSTU 8302:2015 "Information and documentation. Bibliographic reference. General requirements and rules of compilation"*).
- References in the text are placed in square brackets, with continuous numbering.
- Pages are not numbered.
