Features of the course, teaching and learning methods, and technologies

Lectures are conducted using multimedia technologies. Game methods are used in practical classes, attention to information technologies in law enforcement is emphasized. Educational materials are placed in Teams. |

Program of the course

Topics of the lectures

Topic 1. Law as a social system.

Concept and characteristics of law. Functions and principles of law. Legal system and its structure. Sources of law.

Topic 2. Constitutional Law of Ukraine.

Basics of the constitutional order in Ukraine. Fundamentals of the legal status of individuals and citizens in Ukraine. Constitutional and legal status of the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine. Constitutional and legal status of the President of Ukraine. Constitutional and legal status of executive bodies in Ukraine.

Topic 3. Civil Law of Ukraine as a branch of law.

Subject and method of civil law. Civil legislation. Concept and content of civil legal relations. Concept of civil law objects and their classification.

Topic 4. Subjects of civil law.

Legal status of civil law subjects. Concept and general characteristics of civil legal capacity and civil legal capacity. Legal capacity of individuals. Legal entities and individuals as participants in civil legal relations. Legal entities: concept, characteristics, classification. Concept and types of civil law objects. Participants in civil legal relations. Personal non-property rights of individuals and legal entities and their protection. Property rights of individuals and legal entities.

Topic 5. Objects of civil law.

Concept and types of civil law objects. Material and immaterial goods. Things, actions, results of intellectual creativity, information, personal non-property goods. Classification of things.

Topic 6. Transactions.

Concept of transactions, conditions of their validity.

Topic 7. Civil law contract.

Civil law contract: concept and types. Content of the civil law contract. Liability of the parties for breach of contract terms.

Topic 8. Basics of intellectual property law and artificial intelligence.

Concept of intellectual property and its legal protection system. Objects of intellectual property rights. Commercialization of intellectual property rights. Concept of artificial intelligence and its legal regulation. Copyright on objects created by artificial intelligence.

Topic 9. Marriage and family legal relations.

State registration of marriage. Property relations in marriage and family. Personal non-property relations in marriage and family. Termination of marriage.

Topic 10. Labor legal relations.

Labor contract as a special form of employment agreement. Grounds for termination of labor relations. Material liability of employees. Procedure for resolving individual and collective labor disputes (conflicts).

Topic 11. Main legal grounds and principles for ensuring academic integrity and their application in professional activity.

Concept of academic integrity. Legal sources for applying academic integrity in Ukraine. Regulatory framework for the implementation of academic integrity principles.

Topic 12. Concept of academic integrity in higher education.

Introduction to the issue of academic integrity. Documents regulating integrity in Ukraine. Types of academic integrity violations.

Topic 13. Basics of administrative law of Ukraine.

Concept and characteristics of an administrative offense. Types of administrative penalties.

Topic 14. Basics of criminal law of Ukraine.

Concept of a criminal offense and responsibility for committing it.

Topic 15. Main directions of anti-corruption activity in Ukraine and their legal regulation.

Theoretical approaches to the study of the corruption phenomenon. Historical aspect of the problem. Concept of "corruption", its characteristics, forms, types, causes, and consequences. Conflict of interest, its types, and connection with corruption. Practical issues of preventing and combating corruption. International experience in combating corruption. Specialized state bodies and institutions in Ukraine for combating corruption. Legal responsibility for corruption or corruption-related offenses and elimination of their consequences in Ukraine.

Topic 16. Corruption in higher education.

Corruption in higher education and its manifestations. Causes of corruption in higher education institutions. Ways to overcome and prevent corruption in higher education institutions. Law: basic concepts.

Topics of the workshops

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Concept and characteristics of law. Functions and principles of law. Legal system and its structure. Sources of law.

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Topics of the laboratory classes

Laboratory work within the discipline is not provided.

Self-study

The course involves studying lecture material, preparing for seminar classes, and independent study of topics and issues that are not taught in lecture classes. Students are also recommended additional materials (official websites of state authorities, judicial authorities) for independent study and analysis.
